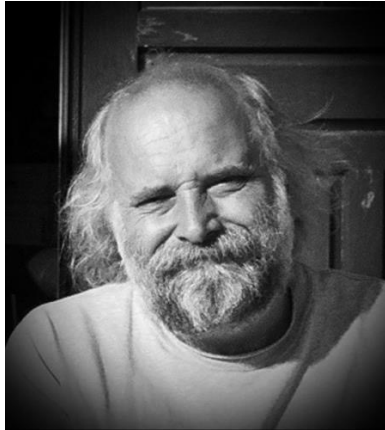


Christopher M. THORNTON (October 11, 1958 - December 02, 2017)
